Overview

The African-American Youth Female Leadership Summit, the **I.N.S.P.I.R.E.** Project, a signature program of NABSE, is accepting registration documents from applicants willing to donate their time, knowledge and leadership skills to help **Inform,, Nurture, Support, Prepare, Inspire, Reward, Empower** middle and high school students currently in the 8th, 9th and 10th grades.

The summit will be held: July 19-21, 2019.

Central State University

Summit participants will attend small and large group sessions on campus and be supervised at all times by these heroic volunteering women.

Objectives

This summit offers students training in the following:

- Enhanced leadership skills;
- Safe positive alternatives/vision for the future;
Understanding of state and local government;
- Financial responsibility
- Media influences
- Living a balanced life; and
- Career exploration and development.

Activities

Students attending the summit will:

- Attend thought provoking presentations on critical leadership skills;
- Explore diverse backgrounds and ideas in group discussions;
- Participate in interactive workshops promoting good mental, physical and financial health;
- Enjoy tour of Central State University and Wilberforce University.

Female volunteers/chaperones/speakers will:

- Partner with two other volunteers to present specific topics;
- Participate in small group sessions with young ladies;
- Lead and participate in fun activities with the youth;
- Interact with youth and others during meals;
- When possible, stay in dormitory where students will be housed;
- Help secure sponsors for the summit.

Cost

The volunteers are self-funded for their transportation to and from Detroit, Michigan and back home and for all other expenses. This will be a "**PAY BACK**" or **PAY IT FORWARD WEEKEND**". There will be a limited number of rooms on campus for \$30.00 per night. There are many hotels within a few miles to the Central State University Campus. All materials to be used during the summit will be provided to the adults.

Eligibility

Meals, program materials and transportation to the summit site provided to the students. **NABSE affiliates** will be asked to work with parents to pay for transportation for one or two students from her home to Wilberforce, Ohio and her return home. Students will pay **\$25.00** registration fee. Other expenses for students will be obtained through donations and sponsorships.

Presenters/volunteers/chaperones who are willing to serve and give of themselves are encouraged to apply. NABSE expects:

- All adults will be back ground checked and must be **felony** free.
- All adults to demonstrate leadership potential (i.e. involvement in education of children, community leadership or similar activities)
- That a drug, alcohol, and smoke free adult environment will exist the entire weekend.
