

## Guidelines for Manuscript Submissions

The *Journal of the Alliance of Black School Educators (JABSE)* publishes conceptual and empirical articles that contribute new knowledge and ideas in the quest for excellence in educating marginalized students. Each issue has general interest articles, interviews, and/or book reviews.

Anonymous referees will review each manuscript submitted to *JABSE* unless they are inappropriate due to length, style, or topic. Manuscripts that do not meet submission requirements will not be reviewed. Articles are judged on the following:

- Significance to the field of education
- Comprehensiveness of the literature review
- Quality of writing, clarity, and format
- Significance of conclusions and implications for future research, practice, or policy
- Adequacy of the rationale and appropriateness of the design and analysis

The editor reserves the right to make changes in all manuscripts to improve clarity, conform to style, and correct grammar. Manuscripts that exceed space limitations will not be considered. Under no circumstances will a manuscript be considered if the author does not fulfill all submission requirements by the issue deadline.

### MANUSCRIPT ACCEPTANCE POLICY

Notification of manuscript disposition may take several months. A publication release agreement form (or copyright waiver) is sent to the author(s) with notification of acceptance for publication. Accepted articles will not be published until the editors receive the waiver from the author(s) with an original signature(s).

### SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

#### **Feature and Research Manuscripts:**

All manuscripts must be submitted electronically. The editor will submit manuscripts for blind review; therefore, no identifying information must be listed on the abstract or manuscript. Authors must forward a complete MSWord copy via email to [wesboy@att.net](mailto:wesboy@att.net).

- 1. STYLE:** Authors must follow guidelines in the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (7th Edition)* for all elements of the manuscript.
- 2. TYPING:** The main text should be typed double-spaced. All other text, including title, headings, references, quotations, and figures captions must be typed single-spaced. Tables, figures, and graphics must be formatted appropriately and copy ready. One-inch margins and Times New Roman, 12 point font are required.
- 3. COVER PAGE:** Authors must include their name, title, institution, mailing address, home and work phone numbers, fax number, and e-mail address. A brief narrative description of each author's academic and professional background must be provided.
- 4. ABSTRACT:** An abstract describing the essence of the manuscript must be included. It must be no more than 120 words and typed single-spaced on a separate page. They must also provide a copy of the manuscript with all identifying information removed from the cover page for the blind review process.
- 5. MANUSCRIPT:** The manuscript, including all references, tables, and figures, must not exceed 45 pages. Tables and figures must be formatted with MS Word Tables and included within the text, not attached at the end of the paper. Bold text is not allowed, and all pages must be numbered.

### BOOK REVIEWS

Reviews should not exceed 10 double-spaced, typed pages and include city, state, publisher, and the year of the book's publication. Authors must send the review and a cover page in MSWord format via email manuscript to the journal editor at [wesboy@att.net](mailto:wesboy@att.net).
